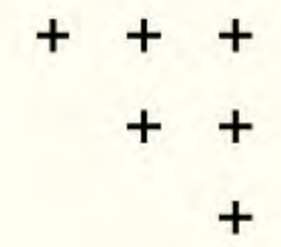


**The sacrificial love of Jesus leads the church

of God for the work that they had fulfilled.
