Fellowship family, thank you for your generosity over the last few months. \$580,000 was donated to The Gift in December and the Elders have distributed those funds.

\$250,000 from The Gift has been allocated to Fellowship Bentonville, and \$100,000 will be designated to the construction of a Counseling and Care Center on the southwest corner of the NWA campus, which will also house our One-to-One ministry. 44% of the funds you donated from The Gift and Disaster Relief will provide assistance in the Middle East, as well as here at home, aiding the poor, homeless, disadvantaged, disabled, and disenfranchised. Five new water wells will be dug in Africa and mission efforts will receive funds across the globe. We continue to assist partner churches and church plants in their efforts, as well.

So, once again, thank you for your wise stewardship of life, which is making a difference in the lives of so many—locally, regionally, and globally.
