Exodus 15:22-23 *nasb*

Then Moses led Israel from the Red Sea, and they went out into the wilderness of Shur; and they went three days in the wilderness and found no water. ²³ When they came to Marah, they could not drink the waters of Marah, for they were bitter; therefore it was named Marah.

Exodus 15:24-25 *nasb*

So the people grumbled at Moses, saying, “What shall we drink?”
²⁵ Then he cried out to the LORD, and the LORD showed him a tree;
and he threw it into the waters, and the waters became sweet.
There He made for them a statute and regulation, and there He
tested them.

Jehovah Rapha



The Lord is my Healer.

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Rapha- means to heal (both figurative and literal healing), to make whole, to restore to normal (restore health), to cure, to repair.

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God let the Israelites know that He is the God who heals. What He actually said is stronger than that. It's not so much, "I am the God who heals" as it is, **"HEALING IS WHAT I AM."**

Luke 7:19-20 *nasb*

Summoning two of his disciples, John sent them to the Lord, saying, “Are You the Expected One, or do we look for someone else?” ²⁰ When the men came to Him, they said, “John the Baptist has sent us to You, to ask, ‘Are You the Expected One, or do we look for someone else?’”

Luke 7:21-22 *nasb*

At that very time He cured many people of diseases and afflictions and evil spirits; and He gave sight to many who were blind. ²² And He answered and said to them, “Go and report to John what you have seen and heard: the BLIND RECEIVE SIGHT, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, the POOR HAVE THE GOSPEL PREACHED TO THEM.”

Then the LORD said to Moses, “Make a fiery serpent, and set it on a standard; and it shall come about, that everyone who is bitten, when he looks at it, he will live.”⁹ And Moses made a bronze serpent and set it on the standard; and it came about, that if a serpent bit any man, when he looked to the bronze serpent, he lived.

Then he showed me a river of the water of life, clear as crystal, coming from the throne of God and of the Lamb, ² in the middle of its street. On either side of the river was the tree of life, bearing twelve kinds of fruit, yielding its fruit every month; and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. ³ There will no longer be any curse; and the throne of God and of the Lamb will be in it, and His bond-servants will serve Him...
