Have you had an experience where someone else’s presence completely changed the situation? Maybe it was a teacher, a parent, or a policeman. What changed when that person showed up?

GROW

Read John 14:25
To what is Jesus referring when He says “these things” (ESV) or “all this” (NIV)? Take a moment as a group to review the Upper Room Discourse to this point. What are the major points of each section between 13:1 and 14:24?

Read John 14:26

Go around the room and share the different translations you have for the descriptive name of the Holy Spirit (i.e. Counselor, Advocate, etc.). What do these words tell you about the role of the Holy Spirit? What does Jesus specifically say the Holy Spirit will do in this verse? How does the Spirit accomplish these tasks today? Share with the group how you have experienced the work of the Spirit in your own life.

Read John 14:27

How would you describe the peace that Jesus is talking about in this verse? What is the difference between the peace the world gives and the peace Christ gives? Have you ever experienced a “troubled heart”? How can we obey the command of Jesus to “not let our hearts be troubled and not be afraid”?

Read John 14:28-31

Who is the ruler of this world? Why does Jesus say he has no claim on Him? What does that mean for us as followers of Jesus? How does Jesus demonstrate His love for the Father (John 14:31)? How do we demonstrate our love for Jesus (John 14:15)?

How is your peace? What could you do to experience more of the peace of Christ in your life? Pray for each other, pray specifically for those who are experiencing troubled hearts.
