BELONG

Have you ever felt out of place or found yourself somewhere that you did not belong? Tell about it. What were the circumstances? How did you feel?

GROW

Read John 15:9-25. A number of groups and individuals are mentioned in this passage: "world," "disciples," "Jesus," "the Father," and "the Counselor" (the Holy Spirit). How is each described, and how do they relate to one another?

Consider the contrast made in John 15:9-17 and 15:18-25. In the first part, the Apostle John describes the relationship between Jesus and His disciples as one of "love;" however, in the second part, he describes the relationship between the world and Jesus' disciples as one of "hate." What can we learn from these contrasting statements?

In John 15:20 we find two rhetorical "if," statements. Jesus tells His disciples they will face persecution and they will be followed by other disciples. Why is it important for Jesus' followers to know and understand these realities? How does this help us today?

In John 15:22, and 15:24 we see that Jesus' presence has highlighted the guilt of the world. How? Why is it important to know the Counselor (the Holy Spirit) will be sent, and that He will testify on behalf of Jesus?

How can knowing that disciples will be persecuted and that the Counselor has been sent help keep believers from going astray?

How do we stay encouraged in the face of struggles and hurdles that the world throws at followers of Christ?
