Do you tend to think a little too much of yourself or to view yourself too lowly? In other words, do you tend toward arrogance or toward low self-esteem? What do you do to try to overcome your natural tendency to think too much or too little of yourself? Why is an honest view of ourselves so hard to achieve?

GROW

Read [John 13:1-17](#)

Review what happened in [John 13:1-11](#) (our first lesson in the Upper Room Discourse.) What would you say is the main theme of the first 11 verses of [John 13](#)?

Jesus asks if they understand ([v. 12](#)). Have you ever had an experience where you didn't understand what God was doing while it was happening, but later you looked back and understood better? Share with the group.

Jesus affirms that He is both Lord and Teacher ([v. 13](#)). Do you view Jesus as your Lord? What does that mean in your day to day life? What about your Teacher? How does Jesus teach you? What are some other descriptive names you would call Jesus? (For more names of Jesus found in Scripture, visit gotquestions.org/names-Jesus-Christ.html.)

What barriers did Jesus break by washing the feet of the disciples? What are some barriers that prevent us from serving each other? What are some barriers that prevent us from serving people outside our immediate circle of friends and acquaintances?

Why do we call this "The Great Example"? What is it and example of? Who do you know in your life who has lived out "The Great Example" well? What did that person do that makes you think of them as someone who lived out the example set by Christ?

The final two statements by Christ in this section refer to messengers and servants. How are those two tasks related? Review these concepts together:

Great Commandment ([Matthew 22:36-40](#))
Great Commission ([Matthew 28:18-20](#),
[Acts 1:8](#))
Great Example ([John 13:14-15](#))

How do the Great Commandment, Commission, and Example all fit together? Where do you need to grow in your walk with Christ, loving, telling, or serving? Who can you serve this week in the name of Jesus?
