James Series—James 2:14-26

Belong

Who is someone you know whose life and actions are a great example of their Christian faith? How does their faith show up in the way that this person lives?

Grow

James begins this section with questions to introduce his topic, offers a simple example, then states his main point. Take a moment to notice these key parts as you read James 2:14-17.

What is James teaching about faith? What kind of faith is he questioning? What does he mean when he says that faith without works is dead?

Notice the way that James expands his argument as you read James 2:18-20. Describe the connection that James makes between faith and works (deeds). What point does he make regarding the faith of demons? Does this surprise you?

What is the problem with separating faith and works? Do you see this as an issue for us today?

Read James 2:21-26. In this final segment, James provides two scriptural examples from the Old Testament. What do these lessons teach us about the connection between faith and works?

Look again at verse 22. What does it look like for us to live with an “active faith” where “faith and works are working together” in our lives?

What are some situations at work, in the home, etc. where this really comes into play in your life? How could this lesson and the examples James provides in this passage encourage you to live out your faith?
