YEAR END GIVING

December is a time of gift giving and if your giving includes Fellowship, here are some timely reminders.

The IRS rules state that contributions are deductible in the year made. So what does that mean for your contributions? Below are some examples of different ways to give and the methods used to determine which year they are deductible. Checks and/or cash mailed and postmarked by December 31, 2017 are considered as a 2017 contribution. Checks and/or cash left in the offering plate are considered as a contribution during the year the service was held.

Online giving that is submitted by midnight December 31, 2017 is considered as a 2017 contribution. If you'd like to donate appreciated assets (stock), contact Greg Seay in order to obtain the transfer instructions and if you are transferring stock, please let us know so we can properly account for your gift.

Your Fellowship contribution statements will be mailed by January 31, 2018. Please log in to your Fellowship account and verify your address prior to December 31 to ensure that our records are correct.
