What was the focus of the disciples' questions when they asked where Jesus was going? Do you think they were concerned for Jesus or themselves? How does the disciples' motive help us understand Jesus' comments in verse 5?

Read John 16:7.

In verse 7, Jesus tells the disciples that it is an advantage to them that He goes away. How is it an advantage to them? What happens as a result of Jesus going away?

Read John 16:8-11.

What does Jesus tell His disciples about the role that the Holy Spirit will have? How have you seen the Holy Spirit do His work? Did this happen before you were a Christian, after becoming a Christian, or both?

Read John 16:13-15.

What does Jesus tell His disciples about the work that the Holy Spirit will do in their lives? How has the indwelling of the Holy Spirit been an advantage in your life? (Consider times of trial, grief and loss, when guidance was needed, sharing the Gospel with others...)

Take time to reflect and prayerfully thank God for giving the Holy Spirit and for the work that He has done in your life. Ask Him to guide you in the truth and work through you to glorify Jesus as you live for Him this week.
