



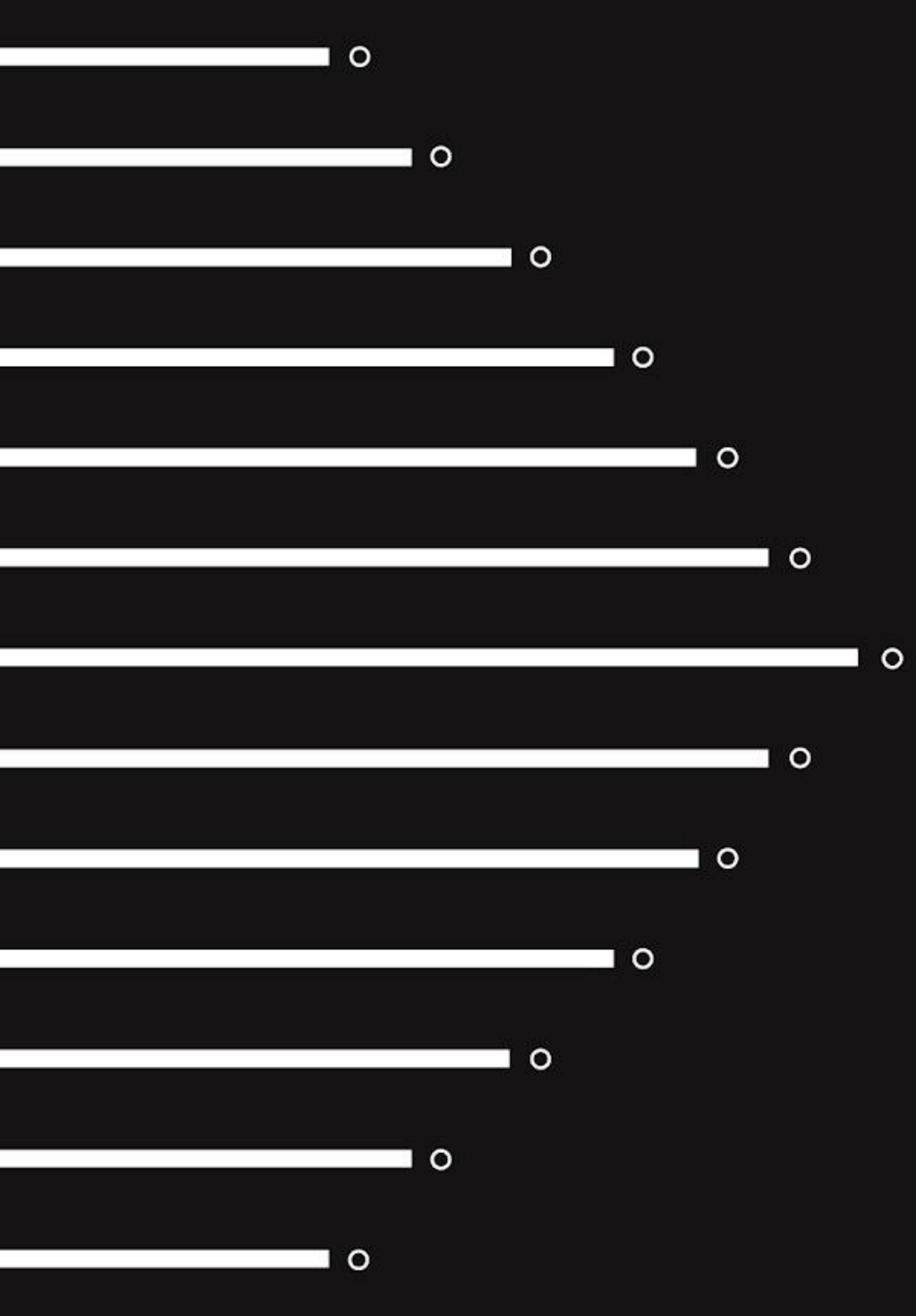

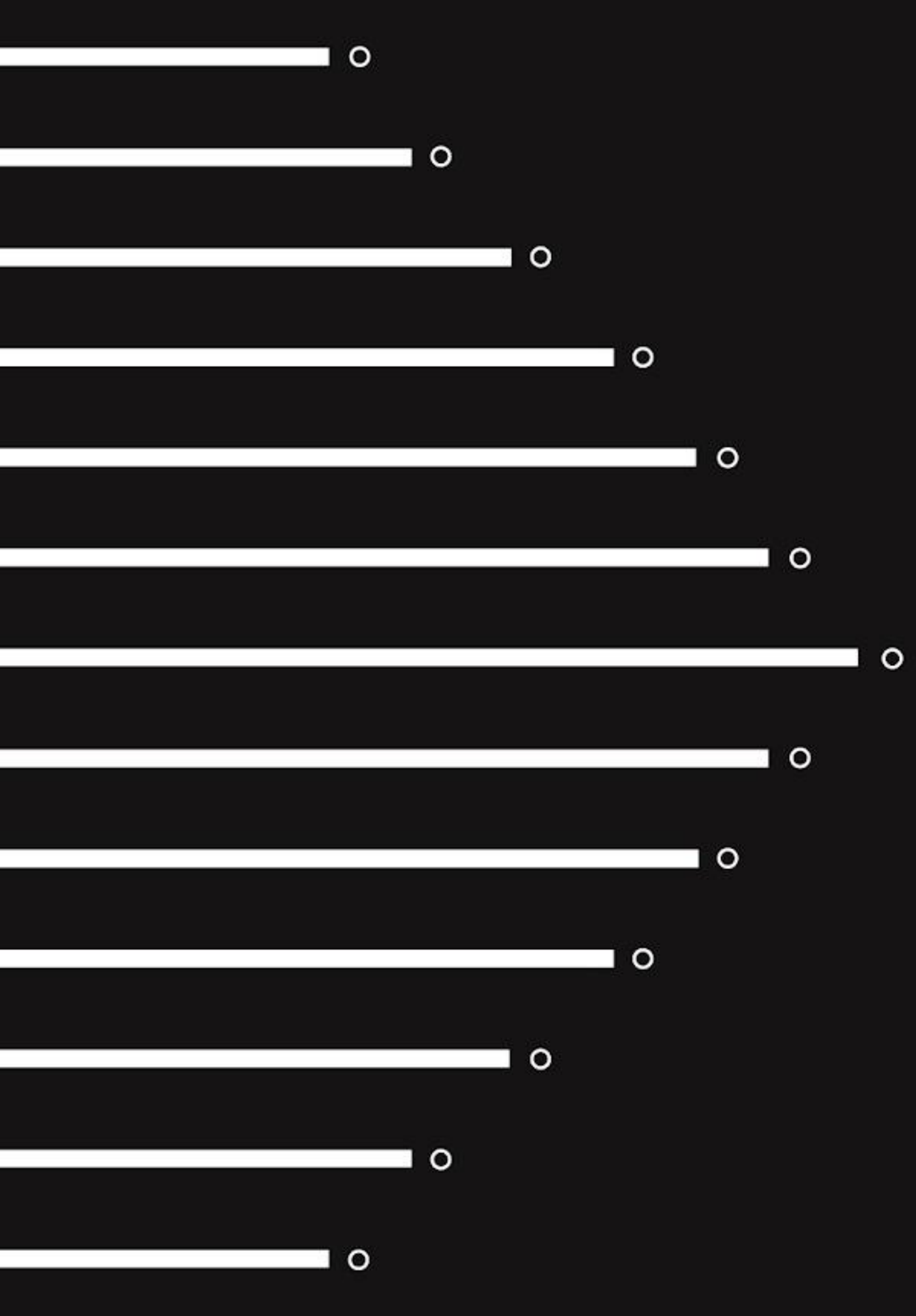

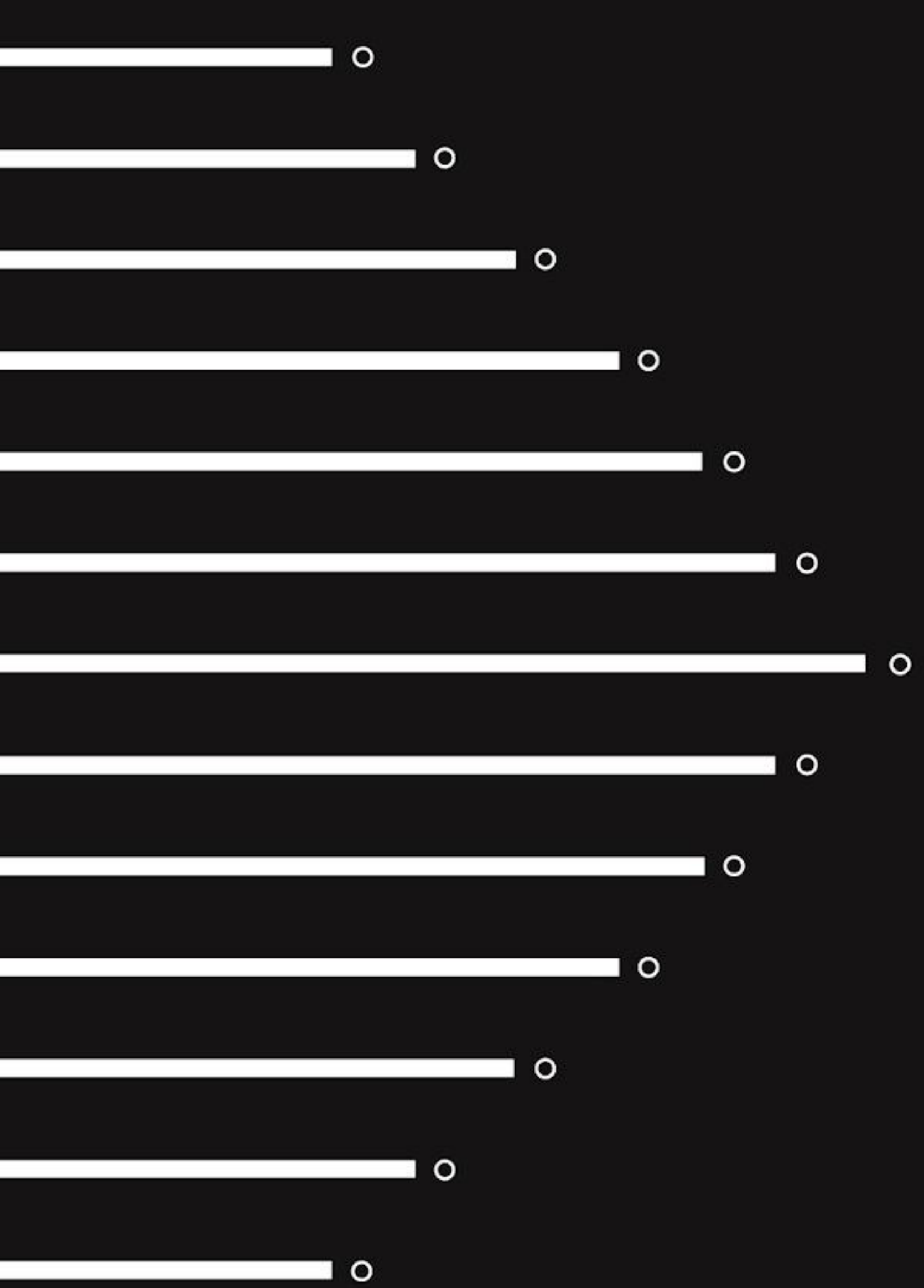


Esther and Mordecai had not returned to the land and did not seem interested in complying with the prophetic command to return...

The Law is never mentioned in the book nor are sacrifices or offerings referred to. Prayer is never mentioned in the book, though fasting is. This fits the view that the Jewish people residing in the Persian Empire **were not following God's will**. They were shunning their responsibility to return to Palestine and to become involved in temple worship...

Both Esther and Mordecai seem to have lacked spiritual awareness *except* in their **assurance that God would protect His people**.

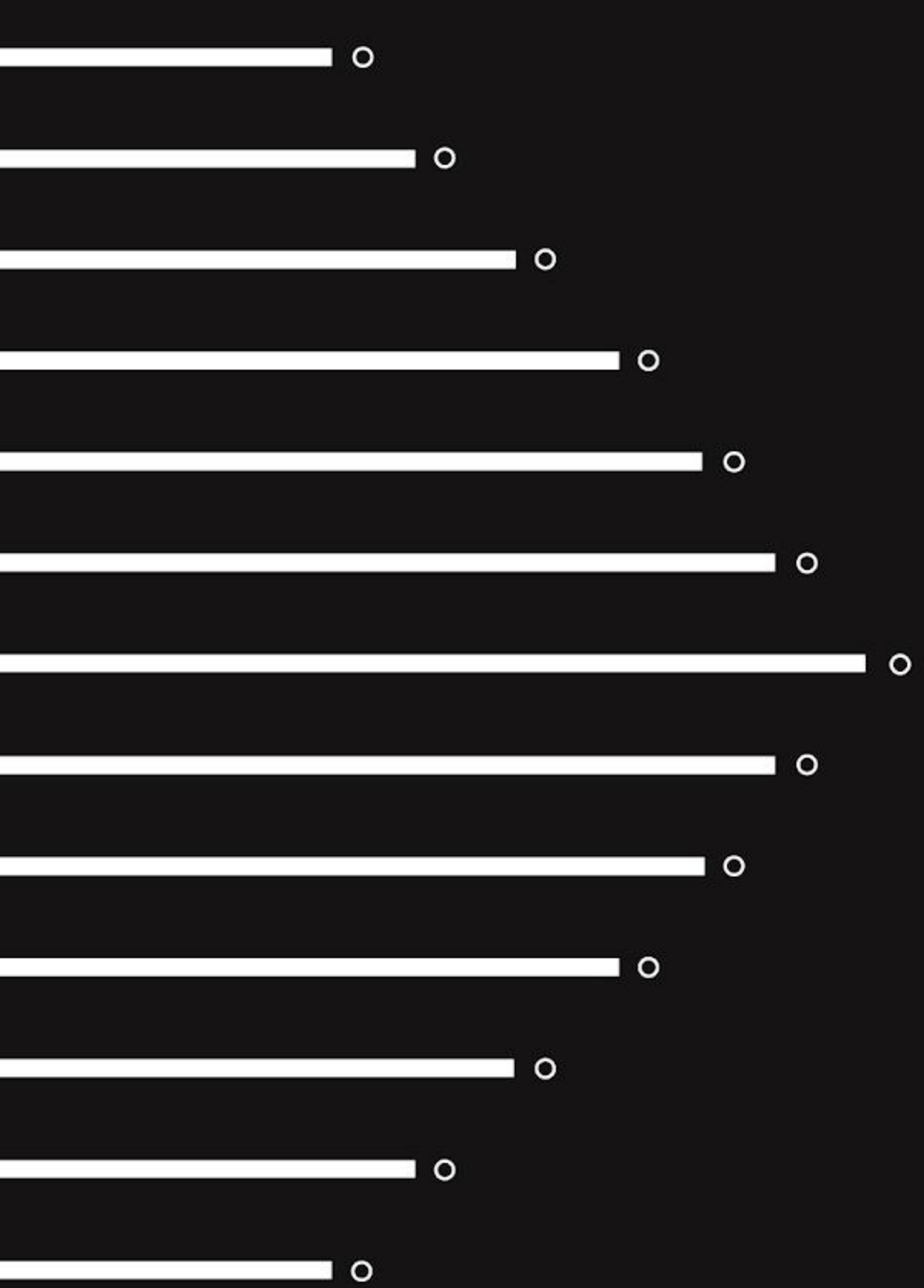
