### BELONG

If you could sit down and talk with Jesus, what questions would you like to ask?

### GROW

Today's passage contains multiple questions the disciples asked Jesus on their last night together. His answers and some additional insights that Jesus includes—provide key insights that are encouraging and explain key theological points for us.

**Read John 13:36-38.** Notice the two questions that Peter asks. What is at the heart of his questioning? What was Jesus trying to communicate to Peter after the first question in verse 36?

**Read John 14:1-4.** What commands and promises does Jesus offer for troubled hearts of His closest followers? How can these commands and promises help us in the challenges that we face today?

**Read John 14:5-7.** Thomas builds on Peter's line of questioning, and prompts Jesus for two landmark statements in verse 6. Read aloud verse 6 and unpack the meaning of "the way," "the truth," and "the life" as it applies to Christians in modern times.

The second sentence in verse 6 is a major theological truth for every believer to understand. What alternative paths do people attempt to use in order to reach out to or connect with God? What does it mean to trust completely in Jesus as the way to the Father?

**Read John 14:8-11.** In this section Phillip, asks Jesus a fourth question. What do you sense about Jesus' tone in the

response found in verse 9? What does Jesus tell us here about the closeness of Himself with the Father? What impact does this truth have for us as Christians?

**Read John 14:12-14.** Jesus wraps up today's passage with encouragement and a promise. What does Jesus mean when He says that those who believe will do even greater works than He had done? What can you take away about prayer from verses 13-14?

As you look back on today's passage, what aspect that you have read or learned about Jesus is most impactful to you?
