
LUKE 1:64-67 ESV








The Benedictus


Part One: 1:67-75 | The Fulfillment of a Promise


"...to show the mercy promised to our fathers and to remember his holy covenant,

⁷⁴ that we, being delivered from the hand of our enemies, might serve him without fear,


