
"Father, the hour has come."

Sanctification

a progressive work of God that sets apart or separates us unto God in position (passive) and condition (active) from that which is unholy (whether people or things)

Three Aspects of Sanctification

Positional Sanctification

Set apart from the world and unto God

Experiential Sanctification - Set apart by

- a. Yieldedness to God
- b. Victory over sin
- c. Growth in Christian maturity

Ultimate Sanctification - Set apart by glorification

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Ultimate Sanctification - Set apart by glorification

As Christians, we must be set apart by the depth of our worship.

John 17:17-19 niv

"Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth. ¹⁸ As you sent me into the world, I have sent them into the world. ¹⁹ For them I sanctify myself, that they too may be truly sanctified. My prayer is not for them alone."

John 17:20-23 niv

"I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, ²¹ that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me. ²² I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one- ²³ I in them and you in me-so that they may be brought to complete unity. Then the world will know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me."

John 17:24 niv

"Father, I want those you have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory, the glory you have given me because you loved me before the creation of the world."

John 17:25-26 niv

"Righteous Father, though the world does not know you, I know you, and they know that you have sent me. ²⁶ I have made you known to them, and will continue to make you known in order that the love you have for me may be in them and that I myself may be in them."
