BELONG

We like to ignore the reality that we resemble our parents in some ways. But we do. In what ways are you like your mom and dad? In what ways are you a lot different than your mom and dad?

GROW

To be created in the image of God tells us...

- *We are of supreme worth and value.*
- *We have significant responsibility (represent and reflect).*
- *We have a great need (restoration of a marred image).*
- *We possess created dignity and we express to others that dignity.*

- 1) How do you think we are like God? What are some ways we represent God?
- 2) Do you think we have lost our image? Why or why not?
- 3) Think of the most despicable people you know. Do they still have the image of God? If so, how should we treat them?
- 4) Seeing the image of God in other people should affect the way we treat them. For example: The elderly, the handicapped (mentally, socially, physically challenged), the seriously ill, the pre-born, those in poverty, homeless, or of a different race.

How do you see these people being treated?

How does this affect our "prejudice"? The way we view all types of people? The way we treat others?

Pause to acknowledge this...

God created everything.

God created humanity (image of God).

Mankind sinned and distorted the image.

God sent Jesus to redeem (restore) humanity.

Redeemed humanity conforms to the image of Christ.

Glorified humanity will return to the untarnished image of God.

In response to this "image of God" reality, how will you pray, think, talk, and act differently this week?

NWA SERVE

Souls Harbor NWA is a transitional living program for men. They serve 20 residents ages 18-65 for six months to one year. The program consists of case management, life skills classes, and workforce development.
