### BELONG

What is something you can share that you have earnestly prayed for someone else that you love?

### GROW

Read [John 17:1-5](#). How does Jesus begin this important time of prayer? Make a list of the theological points about God, Jesus, and eternal life you can find in this short passage.

Read [John 17:6-19](#). What can we learn in this segment about Jesus' perspective on the disciples? What specifically does Jesus pray for the Father to do for the disciples? From what you know about the New Testament, how did God answer these prayers?

How can these prayers for the initial followers of Jesus apply to us as 21st Century Christ followers? What does Jesus pray about that you are most thankful for today? How would you paraphrase verses [14-16](#)?

Read [John 17:20-26](#). In [verse 20](#), Jesus turns His attention to future believers. What does He ask of God the Father in this section of the passage? How does unity among Christians glorify Jesus and the Father?

Focusing on [verse 24](#), consider what this prayerful sentence reveals about Jesus' heart for people. How is His passion for people to know Him reflected in your life? What is one way that you could take a step in the coming week to put Jesus' love for others into practice?

Close this study (and teaching series) by having one person read aloud Jesus' prayer from [John 17](#) as the group prays.
