In most great stories there is a battle between good and evil, a hero and a villain, like Luke Skywalker and Darth Vader. Who is your favorite hero/villain combination? Why?

GROW

In [Genesis Chapter 3](#) we have learned about the first sin and its consequences. Sin has literally broken everything. Mankind has a problem (sin) and is in need of a solution.

Read [Romans 3:23](#) and [6:23](#). Who has sinned and what are the results of sin? What from these verses do you most struggle to understand or agree with?

Read [Genesis 3:14-24](#). How would you define enmity ([3:15](#))? What are some creative ways you can describe the two sides in this epic story?

The division between the woman's and serpent's offspring (seed) represents the battle between God and the evil one (Satan). What do you find interesting about the description of their struggle ([3:15](#))? What might be significant about the woman's offspring being referred to as He? How does reading [Romans 16:20](#) help?

The thread of redemption is woven throughout Scripture. We see it in the Abrahamic Covenant ([Genesis 12](#)) and Davidic Covenant ([2 Samuel 7](#)).

Read [Genesis 49:8-12](#). Jacob, the grandson of Abraham, gives his blessing

to his son Judah. Where do you see a foreshadowing of a coming Redeemer? What imagery is used? How does reading [Daniel 7:13-14](#) or [Revelations 5:5, 9](#) aid you in your understanding?

Read [1 Chronicles 17:11-14](#). We see God speak of both Solomon and a King to come. What is encouraging about this passage? Where does the promise seem to go beyond David's son to a coming future eternal King?

How can these Scripture passages written so long ago impact how we live today?
