



- weekly meeting for accountability

And when he had said these things, he went on ahead, going up to Jerusalem.<sup>29</sup> When he drew near to Bethphage and Bethany, at the mount that is called Olivet, he sent two of the disciples, <sup>30</sup> saying, "Go into the village in front of you, where on entering you will find a <u>colt</u> tied, on which no one has ever yet sat. Untie it and bring it here. <sup>31</sup> If anyone asks you, 'Why are you untying it?' you shall say this: 'The Lord has need of it.'"



Behold, your king is coming to you; righteous and having salvation is he, humble and mounted on a **donkey**, on a **colt**, the foal of a donkey.


