## Belong

What does your name mean? Does your name reflect your personality? What about your family members' names? Do their names reflect who they are? Why is it so hard to imagine someone going by a different name?

How are the settings of creation, accountability, and temple worship related in this Psalm? What is comforting about how God is revealed in this Psalm? What is challenging?

## Grow

Take turns reading through [Psalm 68](#), five verses at a time.

How has your view of God grown through this Scripture and discussion? What is a key takeaway for you this week? How could knowing God by the name *Elohim* help you share Him where you live, work, and play?

Each time you read the word “God” in your English translation, that’s the Hebrew word Elohim. Elohim is associated with God as the Mighty One and Creator God.

Where do you see our Creator God’s control and care for creation in this Psalm? What is God like as Creator, and why is that significant to you personally?

Where do you see the power of Elohim, the Mighty One, in this Psalm? What is God like as Almighty, and why is that important to remember?
