Read **James 1:13-18**. According to James where does temptation come from? Where does temptation not come from?

Focus on James 1:13-15. As you look at these verses, what are some steps in the temptation/sin process?

If temptation is successful, what is the ultimate result?

How does the passage challenge us to respond to temptation?

What is the ultimate deception of temptation?

Focus on James 1:16-18. The passage tells us what doesn't come from God (temptation), but what does come from above?

The passage describes two "births" (v. 15 and v. 18). How is the same illustration used differently?

How can this passage help you resist temptation?

Group action step: Break up into two groups—one for men and one for women. Have each person share a specific temptation that they are resisting and for which they would like prayer/accountability.
