# The Shepherd



He has the right to enter.      **John 10:1-2**

The sheep know His voice.      **John 10:3**

He calls them by name.      **John 10:3**

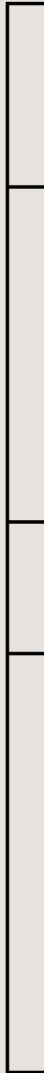

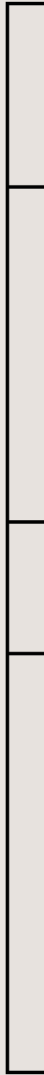

## 1 Peter 5:2-3 NIV

<sup>3</sup> not lording it over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock.
