James Series—James 3:13-18

Belong

How would most people that you know answer the question, "Where does a person find wisdom?"

Grow

This passage contains a clear contrast for true Christians to understand related to living well in God's eyes.

Read James 3:13-18. Focus on verses 13-14.

Why do you think he compares "wise and understanding" with "bitter jealousy and selfish ambition"? Do you see these as opposites? Why or why not?

Serve: NWA

What results should we expect from wise and understanding in verse 13? What could this look like in your life? What warnings are given for battling jealousy and ambition in verse 14?

Read James 3:15-16. James continues on the topic of this type of wisdom that does not come from God. What is wrong with this wisdom? Why is James using such strong language in opposition to Christians relying on this type of worldly wisdom? What damage can be done through the wisdom that comes from jealousy and ambition?

Read James 3:17-18. Have one person "adopt" each of the qualities of Godly wisdom listed in verse 17 to explain how the quality relates to wisdom and provide an example of what it looks like in real life.

What are some ways that we can sow seeds of peace in the relationships of our lives – consider family, work, neighbors, church, school, friendships, etc. What can you do to sow peace and/or seek God's wisdom this week in a situation that has been challenging for you?
