



JOHN 20:19-31

**John 20:19a NET** 




# Jesus Appears to the Disciples

## Jesus Appears to the Disciples

When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the **disciples rejoiced** when they saw the Lord.

Fear turns to **joy** because Jesus appeared!

Now Thomas (called Didymus), one of the twelve, was not with them when Jesus came.

<sup>25</sup> The other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord!" But he replied, "Unless I see the wounds from the nails in his hands, and put my finger into the wounds from the nails, and put my hand into his side, I will never believe it!"






