Read John 13:31-35. As you read the whole passage again, what two words are used most often? How many times for each? Often in the Scriptures, authors use repetition to make a point, what might the repeating of these words tell us?

What is Jesus telling the disciples the defining mark of their lives and community should be? How should that impact the way we live today?
