#### **BELONG**

What qualities do you think are most important in a leader? Why?

### **GROW**

**Read 1 Thessalonians 2:1-12.** Step through these verses and identify ways in which Paul (and others with him) shared the Gospel and taught the people in Thessalonica about the Lord. Notice the mindset, motivation, how they treated the people, and what they sought to teach.

What can you learn from Paul about effective Christian training (discipleship)? Have you experienced a Gospel-centered leadership like this before? How did it impact those under and around the leader?

How could you apply more of the servant-based leadership qualities that Paul demonstrates in all areas of your life? Where and how could you put them into practice?

How could you seek to intentionally grow as a spiritual leader? Who could help guide or train you in some way?

Going Deeper: The word "Gospel" is a key word that Paul uses four times in 1 Thessalonians. "Gospel" literally means "good news." Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-7 and see how Paul clearly defines "Gospel" for us. How would you state the Gospel and in your own words to a friend?

How has this passage challenged you? How has it helped you to understand Christian leadership and the Gospel more clearly?
