What was your most impressive accomplishment as a kid or what is the most impressive thing you've ever heard about a kid doing?

2 CHRONICLES 34:1 says that Josiah became king at age 8. What challenging situation did you have to overcome as a kid and who helped you face this challenge?

2 CHRONICLES 34:3 tells us how old Josiah was when he began to seek the Lord. We're also told about the subsequent decisions that he began making in his leadership. At what age did you begin to follow the Lord and what changes occurred in your life?

2 CHRONICLES 34:19 shows Josiah's strong response to hearing God's Word spoken. Do you remember a time when a verse or passage of Scripture hit you hard? What was the verse or passage? What struck you about it, and what was your response?

2 CHRONICLES 34:27 gives us a clear picture of the type of attitude that impresses the Lord. Read I Peter 5:5 as a parallel New Testament passage. How do you define humility? Who is one of the most humble people you know? Describe what humility looks like in their life.

Generosity is a clear theme of **2 CHRONICLES 35:7-9**. What are some recent examples of generosity you have seen or heard about? What are some common attributes you've noticed about generous people? How do you want to be more generous?

2 CHRONICLES 35:18 tells us a shocking fact about how long the leaders of Israel had half-heartedly observed one of the most central spiritual practices in Israel's worship. What are the spiritual practices you regularly engage in during your worship of the Lord? What happens in your life when you neglect these disciplines?
