What is an example of a painful experience in your life that has resulted in joy?

GROW

Read John 16:16-22. How did the disciples react to Jesus' "in a little while" statements in verses 17-18. Has there ever been a question you have wanted to ask the Lord but think it's too silly of a question to ask Him?



In verses 19-20, what did Jesus tell His disciples would happen to them? How would you have responded to Jesus' words? Anxiety? Anger? Relief that He was speaking plainly?

To what did Jesus compare His disciples response to His departure and return in verses 21-22? In what ways does the world's joy (vs. 20) contrast with the joy the disciples will experience (vs. 22)?

Read John 16:23-24. What instruction does Jesus give the disciples about prayer in this section? What does it mean to ask in Jesus' name? What are some things God has given you when you've asked for them in Jesus' name?

Read John 16:25-33. Why does the Father love the disciples (see verse 27)? In verses 32-33, what did Jesus predict the disciples would do, and what is His hope for them? Why did Jesus tell them to take heart? How does knowing that Jesus will return make you joyful?

What troubles have you experienced in this world? How has knowing Jesus helped you walk through these trials? What encouraging Bible passages have you relied on? What grief/sorrow do you currently need to entrust to God?
