James Series—James 1:19-27

### Belong

What is your temper like? Do you tend to have a short fuse or do you smolder for a while? Has this changed over time?

### Grow

**Read James 1:19-20.** What does it really mean to be "slow to speak, slow to anger?" Look again at verse 20. How can knowing this help to control anger?

Is it ever OK to be angry? If so, when? When does anger become a sin? When are you most likely to lose your temper?

**Read James 1:21-25.** Notice the strong commands given in verses 21-22 regarding the Word of God. What advice does James offer in these verses for living as followers of Jesus?

Try putting into your own words the contrast made in verses 23-25. How does the illustration of looking into a mirror but forgetting what you look like help you to understand James' point about putting Scriptural truth into practice? Give an example of being a "doer of the word."

Focusing on verse 25, explain how the "law" brings "liberty."

Read James 1:26-27. What check points does James give in these two verses for a heart that is "undefiled before God?" Would you expand his list of the "least among us" to include more than "widows and orphans?"

Which of these check points is most challenging for you? What is God teaching you that you can put into action this week?
