Grow

The book of James challenges believers in Christ to live differently than the world. Today's passage focuses on the words that Christians speak—the taming of the tongue.

Read James 3:1-12. Focusing on verses 1-2, what is James' warning for those who teach? Why would teachers of God's Word have greater responsibility for their words than others?

Read James 3:3-5. In this section, the tongue is compared with three examples from real life. What are they and what can we learn from each one? What is James saying about the words that we say?

Read James 3:5b-8. Again, James uses multiple examples to illustrate his warning about the tongue and the words that we speak. In what kinds of situations are we most tempted to sin with our words? When are we most likely to use our words for good?

Read James 3:9-12. How are you doing with the challenge issued in verses 9-10? How could this kind of thinking help us in everyday conversations with family, friends, co-workers, customers, etc.?

This topic of "taming the tongue" comes up over and over in scripture. Take time to look up and read the following passages: [Psalm 141:3](#), [Proverbs 15:28](#), [Proverbs 21:23](#), [Proverbs 26:20](#), [Matthew 15:11](#), [Ephesians 4:12](#), [Colossians 4:6](#), [1 Peter 3:10](#).

What has stood out to you the most from this passage in James? What have you learned that you can apply in your personal spiritual journey this week?
