What’s your “pet peeve”? What will drive you to distraction (or cause you to grumble) every time? Are you someone that is often annoyed, or does it take a lot to get a complaint out of you?

Grow

Read [Exodus 15:22-27](#).

This text takes place just after the crossing of the Red Sea. The first part of chapter 15 is a song of praise for God’s deliverance. How would you describe the state of the hearts of the people of Israel in [15:22-27](#)? How does it differ from the start of chapter 15? What do you think changed?

What does Israel learn about Yahweh in this passage? How is God as “healer” connected to His provision of water for them in the wilderness? How does [verse 27](#) help you understand what God is doing in this story?

Does it ever seem like God is strange and distant? That maybe He has led you to a place of bitterness? How do those feelings affect your ability to trust Him for healing (physically, emotionally, etc.)? In those experiences, what helps you grow in faith, hope, and love?

Read [John 4:13-14](#).

How does the episode at Marah in Exodus 15 help us understand Jesus’ statement in John 4? How does the water that Jesus provides lead to healing (physical, emotional, etc.)?

Read [Revelation 21:1-5](#).

What is the ultimate answer from God to every request for healing? How might the assurance of the full and complete healing that God promises in the new creation affect the way that we pray for healing today?

Spend some time together asking God to heal the brokenness (physical, emotional, etc.) that you see in yourselves, in each other, and in the world around you. Finish by thanking Him that the ultimate answer to healing is ALWAYS yes, even if it may not be experienced fully until His Kingdom comes in the new creation.
