Grow

Take turns reading through [Psalm 86](#), a few verses at a time.

The name for God, "*Adonai*," is usually translated as "Lord" and is used seven times in this Psalm. *Adonai* is associated with the Lord as the Ruler of All who is worthy of total allegiance.

What kind of Lord or Ruler is God in this passage? What does pledging allegiance to the Lord look like in this Psalm?

Is there anything surprising to you about how the Lord is approached or how the Lord expresses His character and authority in this passage?

What prayer request in this Psalm relates to you and where you are in your life right now? What would it sound like for you to pray that request in your own words?

Who or what has the right to rule in your life right now? What might it look like to give more of your life over to Lord? Is there a particular area that comes to mind?

What character aspect of the Lord, *Adonai*, is particularly good news for you to hear right now? How is the character of the Lord good news for the world where you live, work, and play?

Out of Curiosity

A rich faith in Jesus will touch and affect every area of our lives, yet it can sometimes be difficult to know how our faith speaks to a particular situation. Out of Curiosity is a podcast that takes questions we get regularly in small groups and classrooms and gives thoughtful discussion as to how we can approach these questions biblically. Questions range from the weighty and controversial to the more lighthearted and fun. Each discussion is around 15 minutes long, so it can be listened to in one sitting (or workout or commute!). Because complex topics rarely have simple explanations, these discussions do not in any way cover everything that can and should be said about each issue.
