Grow

Read Psalm 23 aloud in its entirety. What is the most impactful line to you personally right now?

Re-read verses 1-3.

What words are used in the psalm that indicate David's assurance in God? When has God given you confidence to walk the path of life that goes before you?

Re-read verse 4.

What words of the psalmist, David, bring you peace and comfort? Share what you are facing in life currently that brings a sense of fear.

List the ways that David is confident of God's protection and guidance. What was the use of the "rod and staff"? How did David deal with "fear"? What followed David? Now put yourself in his place: Does God use a rod or staff with you? What are they?

Re-read verses 5-6.

Consider the conditions by the waterside, on the fragrant grass, at a table filled with provisions, or the touch of soothing oil. What provisions of God have made you feel content?

What sense of hope or security do you feel when you thinking about dwelling with God forever?
