Creative Ways to Live Generously

"Wise Generosity" is the term we use for utilizing the available tools, vehicles, and methods to live not only generously, but with wisdom.

One tool available to those who have assets that have appreciated (stocks and land, for example) includes donating that asset instead of cash. Consider this option for two reasons:

1. When appreciated assets are given, no one pays any tax. No capital gains for you on the gain, and the church doesn't pay taxes.
2. Also, you keep your cash! The cash you've earned can be kept and either reinvested to replace the donated asset or is freed up for other use.

Another tool to consider is making a qualified charitable IRA contribution directly to Fellowship. This is a wonderful way to give generously and take advantage of the tax code.
