







James 4:7-8 (NIV) Submit to God, resist the devil and he will flee from you! ⁸ Draw near to God and He will draw near to you.

Romans 5:12 (NIV) Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all people, because all sinned.

1 Corinthians 15:21–22 (NIV) For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead comes also through a man.²² For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive.
