#### Genesis 15:1-2 esv

After these things the word of the LORD came to Abram in a vision: "Fear not, Abram, I am your shield; your reward shall be very great." <sup>2</sup> But Abram said, "O Lord [Adonai] God, what will you give me, for I continue childless, and the heir of my house is Eliezer of Damascus?"

## **ADONAI** Gracious Master

#### Genesis 15:3-6 esv

And Abram said, "Behold, you have given me no offspring, and a member of my household will be my heir." <sup>4</sup> And behold, the word of the LORD came to him: "This man shall not be your heir; your very own son shall be your heir." <sup>5</sup> And he brought him outside and said, "Look toward heaven, and number the stars, if you are able to number them." Then he said to him, "So shall your offspring be." <sup>6</sup> And he believed the LORD, and he counted it to him as righteousness. Romans 6:17-18 esv But thanks be to God, that you who were once slaves of sin have become obedient from the heart to the standard of teaching to which you were committed, <sup>18</sup> and, having been set free from sin, have become slaves of righteousness.

### 2 Samuel 7:18-20 esv

Then King David went in and sat before the LORD and said, "Who am I, O Lord [**Adonai**] God, and what is my house, that you have brought me thus far? <sup>19</sup> And yet this was a small thing in your eyes, O Lord [**Adonai**] God. You have spoken also of your servant's house for a great while to come, and this is instruction for mankind, O Lord [**Adonai**] God! <sup>20</sup> And what more can David say to you? For you know your servant, O Lord [**Adonai**] God!

# **ADONAI** Majestic Lord

#### Isaiah 6:1-4 esv

In the year that King Uzziah died I saw the Lord [**Adonai**] sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up; and the train of his robe filled the temple. <sup>2</sup> Above him stood the seraphim. Each had six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. <sup>3</sup> And one called to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory!" <sup>4</sup> And the foundations of the thresholds shook at the voice of him who called, and the house was filled with smoke.

### Isaiah 6:5-8 esv

And I said: "Woe is me! For I am lost; for I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts!"<sup>6</sup> Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a burning coal that he had taken with tongs from the altar. <sup>7</sup> And he touched my mouth and said: "Behold, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away, and your sin atoned for." <sup>8</sup> And I heard the voice of the Lord [Adonai] saying, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?" Then I said, "Here I am! Send me."

### Psalm 110:1-7 esv


The LORD says to my Lord [Adoni]: "Sit at my right hand, until I make your enemies your footstool."<sup>2</sup> The LORD sends forth from Zion your mighty scepter. Rule in the midst of your enemies!<sup>3</sup> Your people will offer themselves freely on the day of your power, in holy garments; from the womb of the morning, the dew of your youth will be yours. <sup>4</sup> The LORD has sworn and will not change his mind, "You are a priest forever after the order of Melchizedek." <sup>5</sup> The Lord [Adonai] is at your right hand; he will shatter kings on the day of his wrath.<sup>6</sup> He will execute judgment among the nations, filling them with corpses; he will shatter chiefs over the wide earth. <sup>7</sup> He will drink from the brook by the way; therefore he will lift up his head.
