BELONG

What catches your eye when you go through your mail? What goes straight into the trash and what do you immediately open and read? What does it mean to you in this age of digital correspondence and mass mailings to get a handwritten note or letter? When was the last time you sent a handwritten note?

GROW

Read aloud Galatians 6:11-18.

Why does Paul mention the "large letters" he writes with his "own hand" (6:11)? Review Galatians 4:13-15. What conclusions can we draw about Paul and his writing based on these verses? Why do you think it was important to Paul to write the final words of this epistle with his own hand?

Why does Paul say the Judaizers want the Galatian believers to be circumcised (6:12)? How would circumcision (and following the law) keep them from facing persecution? (For more on Jewish persecution of the early church, review Acts 7:54-8:3, 14:19-20, and

2 Corinthians 11:22-28.)

What does it mean to boast in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ (6:14)? What did the cross represent in the Roman world in which Paul lived? How are you tempted to boast in the flesh rather than in the cross? Take a moment to "boast in the cross" about someone in your group that you have seen God using. Share about the growth you have seen in someone in your group.

Galatians wrap-up

What has God taught you in your study of Galatians? What will you always remember about this small group experience? What has changed in your view of God, yourself, or others, as a result of this study. If you were asked to summarize the book of Galatians in a sentence or two, what would you say.

Consider closing your time together by taking Communion in your group. (For more information on taking communion in your group, contact your community pastor.)
