GROW

Read [John 9:1-3](#). What does the disciples' question reveal about how they viewed blindness (and other health issues)? How does Jesus' response challenge their view?

How are sin and suffering related? How does Jesus' response challenge our views today?

Read [John 9:4-5](#). In these verses, Jesus refers to Himself again as the "light of the world." What does He mean by this, and what is He saying about a "night that is coming"? (Feel free to refer to a study Bible or the recent teaching on this passage.)

Read [John 9:6-7](#). What stands out to you about the method in which Jesus chose to heal this man's blindness? What is an example of a hardship or misfortune in your life that has turned into an opportunity for God to demonstrate His power?

Read [John 9:8-12](#). How did the neighbors and others react to the man once he returned with eyes that see? What do you make of their reaction?

Read [Matthew 5:14-16](#). What does it mean for us to be called by Jesus as the "light of the world"? What has God given you to do while you still have time in this life? Take time to pray for one another regarding these things.

Note: For the rest of today's passage, read [John 9:13-41](#).
